CLUB BUS FOR TEENS

Transportation is currently available via after school van pickups from Tillicum, Tyee, International, and Sammamish. School buses from Odle and Highland drop-off directly in front of our building, as does Metro Rt 226.

A partnership with the City of Bellevue! "The Club" Teen Centers: Grades 6 - 12 Downtown Clubhouse and Lake Hills

Located at 15228 on Lake Hills Blvd. and at The Main Clubhouse in downtown, these teen dedicated facilities provide teens with safe and positive places to be after school. Programs available include drop-in activities, sports, arts, movies, field trips, cooking and leadership Clubs such as Keystone and Torch Club. We also offer homework assistance in our technology center, with high-speed access to the internet. Drop-in and most other programs are free or offered at a very minimal cost.

Drop-in Tutoring

We offer free tutoring after school every day until 6 PM at our Robert Vasen Be Great Graduate Center, located next to The Club teen center, Staff, volunteer, and peer tutors are available to work with students on whatever they need help with, whether it's just getting homework done, preparing for a test, or just needing a quiet place to work. Drop-in Tutoring is open to any student who is interested, the only thing that is required is a completed a BGCB membership form. Transportation directly to The Club is available from most school sites (see above).

Mentorship

Students in need of extra support are matched with a staff mentor to work on specific challenges and facilitate academic achievement. Mentors are available to meet with students during our Drop-In Tutoring, as well as during the school day on specific dates and times (see right). Mentorship is based on the Check and Connect model, with added individualized support and direct instruction based on student needs. Mentorship is available to any students enrolled in the BSD. Enrollment in our Mentorship program requires a completed BGG enrollment packet (including a signed release form for accessing academic records) and a commitment on the part of the student to meet with their mentor at least twice a week.

Ground Zero Music

Multiple offerings include Beat Creation with Ableton Live, Digital Recording, Live Sound 101, Bandcamp 101 and free practice space. BE GREAT Graduate is a FREE award-winning program offered at both teen clubhouses. It is a formal collaboration between the Bellevue School District (BSD), King County Housing Authority (KCHA) and Boys & Girls Clubs of Bellevue (BGCB) with funding provided by KCHA, and other donors including The Robert Vasen Foundation. It is a unique initiative designed to help youth in our community be more successful in school. With one-on-one mentoring, tutoring, and academic planning, the program helps to identify and break down barriers for youth struggling in school and ensures each individual gets what they need to achieve positive academic success.
